

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Vice Chairman's car is unsafe and not road worthy, and

WHEREAS, much travel is required by the Vice Chairman.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that \$4,300.00 be authorized for the purchase of a new vehicle.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the \$4,300.00 be appropriated from funds on deposit with the U. S. Treasury to pay for the vehicle and the budget be amended to reflect the increase.

The foregoing resolution was on November 29, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe, June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

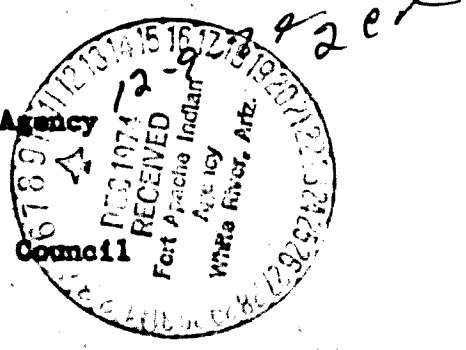

SUBJECT: Tribal Resolution No. 74-170

Resolution No. 74-170 appropriates \$4,300.00 from funds on deposit with the U.S. Treasury for the purpose of a new vehicle for the Tribal Vice-Chairman.

The current tribal budget will be amended to reflect the increase. I hereby recommend approval of the \$4,300.00 increase to the tribal budget.
