WHEREAS, Resolution No. 74-74 and Resolution No. 74-106 were additions to the current year Tribal Budget, and

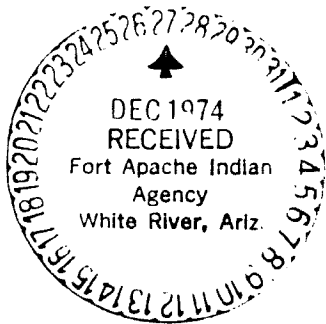
WHEREAS, Resolution No. 74-74 and 74-106 did increase the Tribal Budget \$7800.00 without authority for budget amendment.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that funds be appropriated from the Tribal Funds on deposit with the U. S. Treasurer to amend the Tribal Budget \$7800.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 74-74 be amended \$2800.00 for Council expense.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 74-106 be amended to \$5,000.00 for council expense.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

SUBJECT: Tribal Resolution No. 74-174

Resolution No. 74-174 was made to correct the Tribal record and amend the Tribal Budget.

Resolution No. 74-74 was listed as the wrong resolution and should be 74-106. The \$5,000.00 amendment listed for correction to Resolution No. 74-106 was initially not a resolution and was an increase of \$3,500.00 for the Chairman's expenses and \$1,500.00 increase for the Vice-Chairman's expenses.

We recommend approval of this resolution, even though the resolution on numbers were not correct, and the amendment to the tribal budget. There is an increase of \$2,800.00 for Council Per Diem and an increase of \$5,00.00 as indicated above for an increase in council expenses as a budget item.

The budget amendment is subject to approval by the Area Director.
