- WHEREAS, the United States of America, acting through the Indian Health Service, Department of Health, Education and Welfare, is constructing water supply and waste disposal facilities on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service has requested storage space now used to be provided by the White Mountain Apache Tribe to store materials and equipment for said construction; an agreement to provide such storage space having been read to the Tribal Council.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman of the Tribe and Superintendent are authorized to execute the Agreement to provide storage space.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
