WHEREAS, the established Per Diem rate of \$5.00 per day was inadequate, and

WHEREAS, the Land Operations Committee recommended to the Council that the Per Diem rate should be \$10.00 per day.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that effective immediately that the Per Diem rate for the Tribal Land Operations personnel be \$10.00 per day.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no additional money is appropriated and the increased per diem is to be taken out of the current Land Operations budget.

The foregoing resolution was on December 5, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe, June 27, to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
