

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority has advertised for the position of Director, and

WHEREAS, the applications received have been reviewed by the Housing Authority, and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority recommended to the Council Mr. James D. Sparks be selected as Director of the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribe that they concur with the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority in hiring James D. Sparks as the new Director.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Housing Authority be permitted to enter into a contract with Mr. James D. Sparks for a six-month probationary period.

The foregoing resolution was on December 5, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 2 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
