- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that at a future date this appointment will be reviewed by the Tribal Council and appropriate action taken to fill the position on a permanent basis.

The foregoing resolution was on December 5, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
