

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

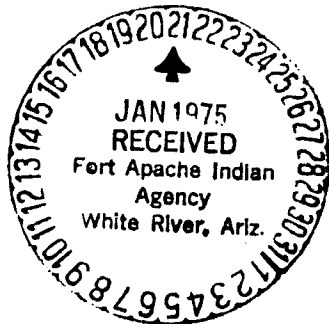
WHEREAS, Resolution No. 74-136 passed on September 11, 1974 directed the Superintendent to cancel a revocable permit issued on May 1, 1974 by Resolution No. 74-70 to the Church of Jesus Christ, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 74-136 required that the permit be cancelled and that a 90-day notice be given for cancellation and removal of the property under the permit, and

WHEREAS, on December 8, 1974, after the general discussion of the Tribal Council, the Superintendent was directed to grant a sixty (60) day extension on the cancellation of the Revocable Permit No. 14-20-OH52-9 that had been established for February 8, 1975.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Superintendent take all action necessary to fulfill the wishes of the Tribal Council on the cancellation of this Revocable Permit No. 14-20-OH52-9.

The foregoing resolution was on January 9, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
