RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, a Revocable Permit No. 2 for the Fort Apache Lutheran Apache Mission has expired, and

WHEREAS, it is the desires of the Tribal Council to renew this permit and keep the mission established.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Revocable Permit No. 2 at Fort Apache be renewed on the same terms and conditions for a ten (10) year Revocable Permit.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman be authorized to sign any and all documents required to consumate this revocable permit.

The foregoing resolution was on January 9, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
