RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has Enos Moody to Rock Creek Road under construction, and

WHEREAS, gravel pit being used near Starrett Riley's is unfit for base and paving gravel, and

WHEREAS, gravel pit below Seven Mile School is suitable and was inspected by Roads Committee, and

WHEREAS, both gravel pits will be cleaned up after use.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs is hereby granted permission to remove gravel by contract and that royalty be hereby waived in lieu of benefits received.

The foregoing resolution was on January 9, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
