WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Whereas, the Tribal Council has discussed the resignation of the General Counsel, Mr. Barry DeRose, and

WHEREAS, for the past eighteen years, Mr. DeRose has faithfully and fully served the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, it is the desires of the Tribal Council to honor Mr. Barry DeRose for his long and faithful service with a dinner and a ceremony fitting for the occasion, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has selected the following members to comprise a committee to organize the organization ceremony.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Superintendent Tim Dye, Eileen Rolfe, Mary Endfield, Nelson Lupe, Sr., Ivan Kitcheyan and Mary V. Riley be the committee to organize and plan for this occasion.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the expenses needed for this event be taken from Public Relations Fund and reasons deemed necessary for the appropriate organization and completion of the ceremony.

The foregoing resolution was on January 10, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

SUBJECT: Tribal Resolution No. 75-17

Mrs. Eunice DeRose, for a number of years, has been the Probate Clerk for the White Mountain Apache Court. There is a need for her services for a period of at least ten (10) months.

Resolution No. 75-17 authorizes the employment of Mrs. Eunice DeRose as Probate Clerk to train an individual member of the Tribe to fulfill the duties of said position. Established fees are as follows: \$35.00 a day for per diem, \$7.00 per hour for work accomplished and a mileage rate of fifteen cents (.15) per mile.

The resolution was adopted on January 10, 1975 by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (q) of the Amended Constitution.
