RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Chaghache Day Care Center on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation serves the low income working parent, and

WHEREAS, during the program year, May 1, 1974, the center received \$56,000. from the Native American Program for salaries and food supplies, and

WHEREAS, this budget is being cut to \$40,000.00 for the coming year, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe realizes the importance of providing day care services in order that our people may be gainfully employed.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe request the Native American Program that the \$16,000.00 be put back into the budget for Fiscal Year 1975-76 in order to re-establish the continued employment of four indigent workers.

The foregoing resolution was on February 12, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (c) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
