

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Recreation Enterprise Board has recommended to the Tribal Council a Special Elk Hunt for 1975, and

WHEREAS, the fee for the Special Elk Hunt to be \$750.00 per hunter, and


WHEREAS, twenty permits will be issued for two hunts, and


WHEREAS, the first hunt will be September 27, 1975 through October 3, 1975 and the second hunt will be October 8, 1975 through October 14, 1975.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that 1975 Special Elk Hunt be held for twenty permits at \$750.00 each.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise supply the required guides and supervision for this Special Elk Hunt.

The foregoing resolution was on February 12, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
