

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Little Bear Lake has been closed for a number of years for lure fishing only, and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Board of Directors for the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise that Little Bear Lake be open for bait fishing, and

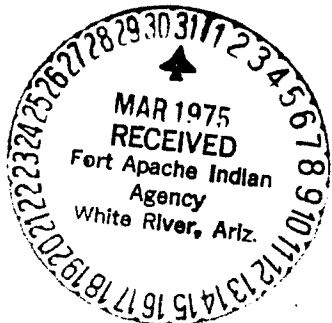
WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise recommend that Cyclone Lake be closed to bait fishing and open only to lure fishing.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Little Bear Lake will be open to bait fishing and Cyclone Lake will be closed and only artificial lures will be permitted for fishing.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the camp grounds around Bog Creek will be closed for overnight camping and campers desiring overnight facilities, use either Horse Shoe camp ground or Big Bear and Little Bear camp grounds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise post these lakes and entrances thereto with these regulations.

The foregoing resolution was on February 12, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
