

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the project to obtain interim housing for employees at Hondah and Sunrise, and other buildings at Hondah, was described to the Council, and

WHEREAS, successful completion of this project depends on expeditious submittal of applications for an Indian Business Development Fund grant, and the Indian Action Team Program, and

WHEREAS, the project as presently envisioned might involve considerable use of the CETA Program, an investment by the Central Tribe in Sunrise, coordination with Northern Arizona Pioneer College, utilization of dead spruce and live aspen, coordination with the Vocational Department at the high school, inclusion of permanent employee housing in next application to HUD, and partial use of the Sunrise Phase III Grant.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman is hereby authorized to sign any and all documents necessary to process the above-mentioned applications, as prepared by the enterprises.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the enterprises are authorized to continue exploring the above-mentioned possibilities, with the understanding that a complete and detailed plan for execution of the project will be submitted to the Tribal Council for final approval prior to implementation of the program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council directs the Housing Authority to include permanent employee housing at Sunrise and Hondah in the pending application to HUD.

The foregoing resolution was on February 12, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
