

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has interviewed four applicants for the position of General Counsel for the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to select Miss Kathy Rihr, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Chairman is to set a date and a time for final negotiation of the contract requirements and salary.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Miss Kathy Rihr is selected as the General Counsel for the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the appointment as General Counsel be contingent upon successful negotiation between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and Miss Kathy Rihr.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the final appointment also be contingent upon the acceptance and approval by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs as required by 25 CFR.

The foregoing resolution was on February 13, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (d) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
