## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been negotiating with Kathleen Rihr to be the General Counsel, and
- WHEREAS, the negotiation has been successful and satisfactory to the Tribal Council.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Kathleen Rihr be hired as General Counsel for the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the base salary be \$36,000.00 per annum, per diem and other expenses to be as specified in the contract.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman be granted permission to sign any and all documents to consumate the completion of the contract.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the current year budget has adequate savings to pay salary and expenses for the remaining part of the current year.
- BE IT FURTEER RESOLVED that the Area Director and others involved act as quick as possible to permit employment on April 1, 1975.

The foregoing resolution was on February 27, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apacha Triba, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (d) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Triba, ratified by the Triba June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
