RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Superintendent announced to the Tribal Council that the Administrative Officer, Mr. Jack Smith had left, and
- WHEREAS, he had appointed, as Acting Administrative Manager, Mrs. Glorianna Dayaye until a replacement is found, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Chairman asked if Mrs. Dayaye was going to have the job permanently, and
- WHEREAS, the Superintendent said that the job must be advertised under the Civil Service Regulation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Chairman indicated a desire for Mrs. Dayaye to have the job permanently.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that if Mrs. Dayaye qualifies under Civil Service rules and regulations, the Tribal Council desires that she receive the appointment.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that any vacancies occuring in the Bureau of Indian Affairs Administration be filled, wherever possible, with tribal members to grant opportunities for advancement and training and management skills.

The foregoing resolution was on March 5, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
