RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the community of Cibecue has the opportunity to receive a \$1500.00 grant, and
- WHEREAS, this grant is to be used for the benefit of the Cibecue Community to establish a community library, and
- WHEREAS, it is the understanding of the Tribal Council that no tribal monies will be expended on the project.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman be authorized and directed to sign any and all documents in behalf of the tribe in the Cibecue Community to receive the grant.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council understands and desires that this will be a responsibility of the Cibecue Community for operation, maintenance and development as a community project.

The foregoing resolution was on March 5, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
