RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Arizona Highway Department desires to improve a portion of State Route 60 at Carrizo by removing the existing narrow bridge and constructing a 461' 2 3/4" concrete bridge, and
- WHEREAS, by virtue of this construction it is necessary that the Arizona Highway Department be granted an additional right-of-way.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman and Superintendent are hereby authorized and directed to grant the Arizona Highway Department a right-of-way and a drainage easement as delineated on the map of Project No. F026-1-418 on file in the office of the Superintendent, Fort Apache Indian Agency, Whiteriver, Arizona.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all damages be waived because of the beneficial result to the Tribe that will ensue by the improvement of Highway 60 and the replacement of the narrow bridge.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon completion of this project, pits and area around new and old bridge will be cleaned up.

The foregoing resolution was on March 5, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
