RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs is to construct sixteen (16) miles of streets in the Whiteriver area, and

WHEREAS, gravel pit is needed to process material, and

WHEREAS, gravel pit below Vincent Bourke's residence is suitable and was recommended by the Roads Committee and the Land Committee, and

WHEREAS, gravel pit will be cleaned up after use and river channel repaired.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs is hereby granted permission to remove gravel by contract and that royalty be hereby waived in lieu of benefits received.

The foregoing resolution was on March 5, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 8for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
