RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, it is the desire of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council to develop, from any source, a shopping center within a Community Culture Complex, and
- WHEREAS, a Schematic Design and Analysis has been submitted to the Council by Henningson, Durham & Richardson of Phoenix, Arizona, and
- WHEREAS, the Council feels that further exploration and study is necessary.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that they shall retain the firm of Henningson, Durham & Richardson to follow through with the project and seek sources of funding from any available source for the completion of the complex.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is the intent of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe to enter into an architectural contract with the firm of
 Henningson, Durham & Richardson of Phoenix, Arizona.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the consummation of the contract will be between the Tribal Council and Henningson, Durham & Richardson in a regularly scheduled meeting.

The foregoing resolution was on April 8, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
