

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 75-41 adopted on March 5, 1974 granted Arizona Highway Department a right-of-way and drainage easement at Carrizo, and

WHEREAS, the first "Be it further resolved, waiver all damages, and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Highway Department are in the process of having this area appraised and will pay the White Mountain Apache Tribe for this right-of-way.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Resolution No. 75-41 be amended to read as follows:

The Arizona Highway Department shall make an appraisal of the area and shall pay the White Mountain Apache Tribe not less than the FAIR MARKET VALUE, for the right-of-way easement.

The foregoing resolution was on April 8, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1985 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
