

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there are many Elderly People residing in the Communities of Cibecue and Carrizo who are unable to provide for themselves nutritionally, and

WHEREAS, people have been trained to prepare and serve one adequate meal five days weekly to these Senior Citizens, and

WHEREAS, this Program has been in immeasurable benefit to the Elderly in the Whiteriver area,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it wishes to apply for a Nutrition Project Award under Title VII of the Older American Act to provide five meals weekly for the elderly at Cibecue and Carrizo.

The foregoing resolution was on April 8, 1975 duly adopted by a vote to 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
