

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe owns and operates the Sunrise Ski Lodge and Hotel, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that a revised and broad Plan of Operation be prepared covering the entire Sunrise Recreation Complex Enterprise, and

WHEREAS, this Plan of Operation covers the entire Sunrise Hotel and Ski Lodge, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors recommended that the Tribal Council approve the broad Plan of Operation and all of the Enterprise Application and Agreement for the Sunrise Recreation Complex Enterprise.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that after due and careful consideration of the Plan of Operation and the Enterprise Application and Agreement for the Sunrise Recreation Complex Enterprise, they are hereby approved and shall henceforth govern all future operations of the Sunrise Recreation Complex Enterprise.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council are hereby authorized and directed to sign the Plan of Operation and the Enterprise Application and Agreement for the Sunrise Recreation Complex Enterprise and to include any acceptable conditions of approval that may be requested by the Area Director and/or the Economic Development Administration.

The foregoing resolution was on April 8, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
