RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the Revocable Permit issued to the Highway Department of the State of Arizona, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to enter into a new Revocable Permit for a period of five years, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to establish an annual rent fee of \$880.00 per annum.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman and the Superintendent are hereby authorized to enter into a five-year Revocable Permit, effective Spetember 1, 1974 at an annual rate of \$880.00 per annum.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Revocable Permit be on the same terms and conditions as the expired permit with the exception of the annual rental fee herein established.

The foregoing resolution was on April 8, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and O against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
