

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to maintain an effective Law and Order Committee which will be concerned with the needs of the Tribe as to Law and Order on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the members of the previous Law and Order Committee appointed in May, 1975 by the new Administration showed the necessary ability to work for the betterment of the Law and Order situation on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the members of the said previous committee; namely, John R. Quintero, Raymond Wright, Ernest Murphy, Lafe Altaha and Wesley Bonito are hereby reinstated into their positions on said Law and Order Committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Lafe Altaha be made Chairman of said committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all prior appointments to said committee other than those made herein are hereby revoked.

The foregoing resolution was on April 17, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
