RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, members of the American Legion Post No. 60 has requested Revenue Sharing Funds in the amount of \$3,000.00, and
- WHEREAS, the Revenue Sharing Funds are to be used for the construction of a fence on the property line to fence the area for the safety of the children and protection of the property.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that \$3,000.00 of the unallocated Revenue Sharing Funds be allocated and used for the construction of the fence.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the American Legion Post No. 60 assume the responsibility of maintaining, in good repair, this fence authorized by the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on May 7, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
