

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council had discussed the rental fees for Permit No. 14-20-OH52-21 Sunny's House of Beauty, and

WHEREAS, it was the feeling of the Council that adequate revenues were not being generated to compensate the tribe for the land used.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the revocable permit for Sunny's House of Beauty not be renewed as a business permit.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the area occupied consist of 0.578 acres being used only for homesite and not business enterprise.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that for the 0.578 acres for use as homesite permit, the fee is established for \$100.00 per month on the basis of a thirty-day revocable permit until there has been an appraisal and a fee established that is agreeable to Leon and Sandra Perry and the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the \$100.00 per month fee be effective at the date of expiration of Permit No. 14-20-OH52-21 which was May 2, 1975.

The foregoing resolution was on May 7, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
