



RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there is currently the sum of \$68,000.00 unappropriated from prior year's Revenue Sharing Funds, and

WHEREAS, there is a need for a portion of these funds to be applied as follows:

1. \$3,000.00 to be spent for miscellaneous hand tools for use by Tribal Work Experience Program and other manpower programs providing general assistance to tribal members.
2. \$16,000.00 to be spent for two farm tractors with plows for the Farm Extension Program.
3. \$11,790.36 to be spent for payment on cattle sale pens at Apache Springs and Haystack which is in addition to the sum of \$48,000.00 previously allocated.

and

WHEREAS, the tribe will receive an estimated \$227,000.00 during the 1976 Fiscal Year from Revenue Sharing, and

WHEREAS, there is a critical need for a theater in Whiteriver to provide entertainment for all of the people at an estimated cost of \$164,000.00, and

WHEREAS, the tribe, due to deficit budget in the current Fiscal Year, does not have funds to pay for these various needs.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that funds in the amount of \$30,790.36 be programmed from current Revenue Sharing Funds as outlined in items 1., 2., and 3. above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds in the amount of \$164,000.00 from current and future Revenue Sharing Funds be programmed for construction of a theater at Whiteriver, Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was on May 8, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
