

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, additional water storage is required at John F. Kennedy School for domestic consumption and for fire protection purposes, and

WHEREAS, an easement is needed for the pipeline route and tank site, and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs is prepared to construct such facility and funds are available.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Council grant the Bureau of Indian Affairs an easement for a waterline and tank site.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the attached plot showing the easement be made a part of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on May 8, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

EASEMENT FOR JOHN F. KENNEDY SCHOOL
WATER STORAGE TANK & PIPELINE

From a point on the centerline of the north end of the Cedar Creek Bridge, N.30°05'30"W., 462.70'; thence N.50°23'30"E., 481.52'; thence S.40°57'30"E., 62.38' to a point of beginning of an easement 25' each side of a line bearing N.40°57'30"W., 332.90'; thence an easement 50' each side of a line bearing N.40°57'30"W., 100.00'.
