RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation has tentatively scheduled the widening and overlay of State Route 73, Post Office Canyon to Whiteriver, Project No. S-215-507, and
- WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation is requesting permission to work on the channels outside of their existing right-of-way and permission to construct a short portion of the new hospital turn out beyond the existing right-of-way.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman and the Superintendent are hereby authorized and directed to grant permission to the Arizona Department of Transportation to work on said channels.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Arizona Department of Transportation shall replace all fences on the original fence lines and said permission granted by this resolution shall expire on December 31, 1976.

The foregoing resolution was on June 4, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
