

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation is planning to pave and seal the Sunrise Road, State Highway 273 from Springerville road to the reservation line (about 5 miles), and

WHEREAS, the Department is requesting an estimated 1600 yards of cinders for the seal coat and such cinders are available at the McNary Pit, and


WHEREAS, the Tribe will be benefitted by this action in that the Sunrise Road would be improved, and the cinder pit would be cleaned up.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Arizona Department of Transportation be hereby authorized to remove cinders from the McNary Pit for the purposes specified herein and at the rate of thirty-five cents (35¢) per yard, payable to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on June 4, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
