



RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribe has encouraged individual members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to enter into business, and
- WHEREAS, Corydon M. and Patricia Cooley have arranged to purchase the Forestdale Trading Post financed by the seller and a Grant from the Indian Business Development Fund Program, and
- WHEREAS, David R. and Helen E. Truax have agreed to sell the Trading Post and relinquish their existing lease, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees to a long term lease to Corydon M. and Patricia Cooley beginning 100 feet right of Station 1273+31.34 on Highway 60 from Globe to Show Low, Arizona. Thence northeasterly along right-of-way 511 feet; Thence S.69°42'E, 168 feet; Thence S.13°18'W., 493 feet; Thence N.74°49'W., 159 feet to the point of beginning. All corners marked with 5/8 inch iron pins. Said parcel of land contains 1.9 acres.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Corydon M. and Patricia Cooley be granted a twenty-five (25) year lease for a business, a trading post, in the above-described area.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the tribal fees be waived for the first five (5) year period and tribal fees to be subject to evaluation of an assessment after the first five (5) year period if the tribe desires.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman be authorized to sign the lease.

The foregoing resolution was on June 4, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 3 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
