RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Fair Commission has requested \$5,000.00 for the 1975 Tribal Fair, and
- WHEREAS, the requested \$5,000.00 will be used for grounds repair, maintenance and personnel, and
- WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council to utilize funds already appropriated.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that \$5,000.00 be set aside for grounds repair, maintenance and personnel.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) be taken from funds available in the budget, Revenue Sharing or any other source.

The foregoing resolution was on July 1, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in itby Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
