FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council had discussed the FHA Frying Pan Project,
and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the council to pursue the project for
increased housing facilities to the White Mountain Apache
people.


BE IT RESOLVED by the council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that
the Vice Chairman, Ivan Kitcheyan be directed to pursue and
complete, if possible, the Frying Pan Project.

The foregoing resolution was on July 1, 1975 duly adopted by a vote
of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White
Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article
V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe,
ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of
the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
