

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the General Livestock Board has the stable concession at Sunrise Complex, and

WHEREAS, each association contributes to the riding remuda, and

WHEREAS, there is a need for housing and quarters for the horses used for the riding stable, and

WHEREAS, the General Livestock Association wishes to make this improvement as a capital investment for the Tribal Herd, and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost is \$5,500.00.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Herd Enterprise Budget be amended by \$5,500.00 in capital improvements.

BE IT RESOLVED that this \$5,500.00 be appropriated from the Tribal Herd monies on deposit with the United States Treasury.

The foregoing resolution was on August 6, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
