## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the United States of America, acting through the Indian Health Service, Department of Health, Education, and Welfare, has agreed with the White Mountain Apache Tribe to install domestic watersupply and sewage-disposal facilities for Indian homes in the East Whiteriver Community, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, Arizona, and
- WHEREAS, a resolution requesting the Indian Health Service to construct these water-supply and sewage-disposal facilities for the residents of East Whiteriver Community, Arizona has been adopted by the Tribe,
- WHEREAS, an agreement has been requested by the Indian Health Service between the Health Service and the White Mountain Apache Tribe; this agreement having been read to the Tribal Council.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman of the Tribe is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement for the construction of domestic water-supply and sewagedisposal facilities for Indian homes in East Whiteriver Community, Arizona, Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on August 6, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
