

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Fair is an annual occurrence, and

WHEREAS, the Activities and Dance Committee has requested Memorial and Alchessay Halls be reserved for the Tribal Fair activities, and

WHEREAS, these activities are essential to the well-being of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Fair.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the three nights preceding Labor Day each year be reserved for the Tribal Fair Rodeo Committee, the Tribal Fair Queen Committee and the Tribal Fair Commission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that annually, these three committees be prepared for the most satisfactory arrangements, the most satisfactory schedule to satisfy the three committees.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the three-named committees cannot come to a satisfactory solution, the final determination and sole responsibility will lay with the White Mountain Apache Tribal Fair Commission.

The foregoing resolution was on August 7, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
