

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Jerry Baylish (a divorced man), Adam and Vernadale (Baha) Burnette, Elton Crocker, William, Jr. and Virginia (Nosie) Dalton, Samuel and Lilly (Toggie) Moody, Leon, Sr. and Alamalee (Pusher) Naha, Richard and Valerie (Gordon) Palmer, Provencio and Cecelia (Declay) Patton, Leonard and Regina (Bead) Perry, Paulene Platt (a single woman), Ross D. and Audrey (Antonio) Susan, Hupp, Jr. and Karen (Chatlin) Sanchez, Alfred and Louella (Altaha) Shroulote, and Stanley and Rosalita (Henry) White, have applied for a loan from the Farmers Home Administration to construct a home, and
- WHEREAS, the Farmers Home Administration requires a residential lease in the names of Jerry Baylish (a divorced man), Adam and Vernadale (Baha) Burnette, Elton Crocker, William, Jr. and Virginia (Nosie) Dalton, Samuel and Lilly (Toggie) Moody, Leon, Sr. and Alamalee (Pusher) Naha, Richard and Valerie (Gordon) Palmer, Provencio and Cecelia (Declay) Patten, Leonard and Regina (Bead) Perry, Paulene Platt (a single woman), Ross D. and Audrey (Antonio) Susan, Hupp, Jr. and Karen (Chatlin) Sanchez, Alfred and Louella (Altaha) Shroulote, and Stanley and Rosalita (Henry) White, the proposed borrowers, and
- WHEREAS, by enactment of Ordinance No. 91, the Tribal Council on May 3, 1972 approved the lease form acceptable to the Farmers Home Administration, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has no objection to the use of this land by the above-named individuals, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has no objection to the lessors mortgaging the leasehold improvements to the Farmers Home Administration.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe does hereby grant and approve a residential lease to Jerry Baylish (a divorced man), Adam and Vernadale (Baha) Burnette, Elton Crocker, William, Jr. and Virginia (Nosie) Dalton, Samuel and Lilly (Toggie) Moody, Leon, Sr. and Alamalee (Pusher) Naha, Richard and Valerie (Gordon) Palmer, Provencio and Cecelia (Declay) Patten, Leonard and Regina (Bead) Perry, Paulene Platt (a single woman), Ross D. and Audrey (Antonio) Susan, Hupp, Jr. and Karen (Chatlin) Sanchez, Alfred and Louella (Altaha) Shroulote, and Stanley and Rosalita (Henry) White as required by the Farmers Home Administration for a period of twenty-five (25) years automatically renewable to an additional term of twenty-five (25) years.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is hereby authorized to approve the mortgaging of the leasehold improvements as required by the Farmers Home Administration.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council is authorized to execute said lease in accordance with Tribal Ordinance No. 91, the effective date the lease shall be the date of loan closing by the Farmers Home Administration.

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WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has a number of claims against the United States which are being prosecuted in Docket No. 22-H before the Indian Claims Commission, and

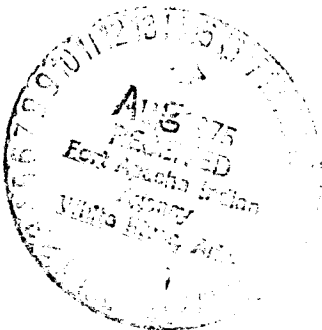
WHEREAS, the Tribe has employed certain ATTORNEYS pursuant to a CONTRACT (Symbol 14-20-0450, Contract No. 5829) to prosecute said claims on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has made application for, and obtained approval of, a loan from the United States to procure expert assistance under the Act of November 4, 1963 (77 Stat. 301), and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has considered a proposed CONTRACT to employ Nicklason Research Associates, of Washington, D. C., to perform historical research, investigation and studies in connection with the prosecution of the Tribe's claims in Docket No. 22-H.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that approval be given said CONTRACT, a copy of which is attached hereto and by this reference is made a part hereof.

The foregoing resolution was on August 7, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (d) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
