RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Court has been without a Chief Judge for nine (9) months, and
- WHEREAS, there is a need to have a Chief Judge in the Tribal Court, and
- WHEREAS, the position of Chief Judge was advertised and recommendation were made by the Law and Order Committee to the Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after much deliberation, wishes to select Vincent Altaha, Sr. as Chief Judge.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Vincent Altaha, Sr. is selected as Chief Judge for the White Mountain Apache Tribal Court.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Vincent Altaha, Sr. is selected by and meets the requirements of Ordinance No. 96, Chapter 1, Part IV, Section 14.2 and Section 14.6.

The foregoing resolution was on August 12, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
