RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the council has considered the request of Mrs. Odette (Cooley) Fuller for the purchase of Canyon Inn from Mr. D. T. Stevens, and
- WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Budget Committee that the transaction be permitted.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the lease belonging to Mr. Stevens be transferred to Mrs. Odette (Cooley) Fuller.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the lease be assigned for the remaining period on Mr. Stevens' lease at the same terms and conditions as is Mr. Stevens' lease.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mrs. Odette (Cooley) Fuller, being a tribal member, that the normal tribal fees included in non-Indian business lease be waived for a period of five (5) years.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman be authorized and directed to sign all necessary documents to consumate the lease assignment.

The foregoing resolution was on September 10, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
