RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, it was reported to the Tribal Administration by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Court that Councilman Fritz Tenijieth has been convicted of misdemeanor, and
- WHEREAS, the Constitution and By-Laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe
 Article IX, Section 1, requires the council to declare the position
 open and the councilman terminated if he has been found guilty, and
- WHEREAS, the court record shows that Mr. Fritz Tenijieth appeared in Tribal Court on September 16, 1975 and was found guilty of the alledged offense.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the information received from the White Mountain Apache Tribal Court has been reviewed and in keeping with the requirements of the Constitution and By-Laws, Councilman Tenijieth is hereby discharged from the Tribal Governing Body and the position declared vacant.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Councilman Fritz Tenijieth is hereby relieved of all duties and responsibilities connected with the Governing Body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, including but not limited to, the Chairmanships of all Standing Committees and other responsibilities that were accrued by reason of the position.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IX, Section 1 (Removal from Office) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
