

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Health, Education and Welfare Committee has recommended that the University of New Mexico conduct a nutrition survey with children of the White Mountain Apache Tribe who are enrolled members, and

WHEREAS, the comparable index would be the nutrition survey of 1969.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the University of New Mexico is given authority to conduct this nutritional survey at no expense to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the University of New Mexico supply the Tribe with a minimum of five (5) copies of the findings, conclusions and of any published reports.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the survey start as soon as possible after April 1, 1976 and be completed before June 30, 1977.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
