RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Enterprise has requested approximately five acres for the expansion of the enterprise, and
- WHEREAS, this designated five acres is to be used to construct approximately twenty (20) apartments to be utilized by Apache Enterprise employees, and
- WHEREAS, the designated five acres will be adjacent to the power line rightof-way and west of the State Highway.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that approximately five acres of land west of the State Highway and south of the Navopache power line right-of-way be used by the White Mountain Apache Enterprise for approximately twenty apartment units for the benefit of the enterprise and enterprise employees.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
