RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council, for the interest and welfare of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, that a Health Authority Director be selected, and
- WHEREAS, the names of applicants have been screened by the Health, Education and Welfare Committee, and
- WHEREAS, the Health, Education and Welfare Committee recommended that Mr. Michael Everett be selected.
- BE IT RESOLVED that Michael Everett is and hereby selected to fill the position of Health Authority Director.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that contract be presented to the Tribal Chairman for his approval covering terms and conditions of the contract for this position.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
