RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the tribe has requested that the Bureau of Indian Affairs construct a new road to serve the community of Cibecue (North) Route 3 and 35, and
- WHEREAS, the tribe wishes to grant a gratuitous right-of-way from the intersections of Route 12 through the community for the road, and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has reinventoried their road system and Route 35 has changed to Route 34, and
- WHEREAS, Resolution No. 74-14 indicates Route 3 and 35 and should read Route 3 and 34.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it grants to the Bureau of Indian Affairs a gratuitous right-of-way as recorded on map on file in the Office of the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency, Whiteriver, Arizona to which reference is hereby made.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
