RESOLUTION OF THE-WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the ONAP program is currently using a four-wheel drive, Recreation Enterprise vehicle, and
- WHEREAS, the operating conditions and costs cannot be supported by the ONAP funded program, and
- WHEREAS, the Council desires to continue to participate in the hot food delivery program.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the four-wheel drive, Recreation Enterprise vehicle be returned to the enterprise and that the tribal budget be amended to reflect an increase of \$3500.00 for the purchase of a suitable vehicle for the hot food delivery program.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that with this budget amendment, additional funds of \$3500.00 be appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in the U. S. Treasury.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
