RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to recognize members of the Governing Body, and
- WHEREAS, this recognition is in the form of lapel pins and belt buckles.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that funds be used from budget savings to purchase 48 lapel pins at a cost of \$648.00 and 11 engraved belt buckles for the price of \$660.00.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the tenure served by Councilmen be engraved on the belt buckles.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$1308.00 be appropriated from savings to pay for the pins and belt buckles.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman be directed and authorized to make those expenditures.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
