## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribe has requested a Grant from Law Enforcement Assistance Administration for the purchase of police cars, and

WHEREAS, the Grant might not be approved, and

WHEREAS, there is an immediate need for replacement of five (5) vehicles, and

WHEREAS, it is imperative that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Police be mobilized.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Budget be amended for \$58,304.00 to purchase the needed vehicles.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funds be appropriated from monies on deposit with the United States Treasurer for the budget amendment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman be authorized and directed to sign all necessary documents required for the budget amendment and advance of funds from the Treasurer.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
