RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 75-163, there is a vacancy on the Tribal Council for a councilman from the Cedar Creek-Carrizo-Forestdale District, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is required by Article IX, Section 3 of the Constitution and By-Laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to fill such a vacancy by majority vote of the Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council requested and received several nominations for such position from the residents of the Carrizo Community, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council selected by secret ballot the nominee, Mrs. Cornelia Hoffman, who received a majority of council votes.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mrs. Cornelia Hoffman be and hereby is appointed to fill the above-described vacancy on the Council for the unexpired term of said Office; said term to begin following her taking Oath of Office at the next regularly scheduled council meeting.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the unexpired term which Mrs. Cornelia Hoffman shall serve is the period from December 3, 1975 to the first council meeting in May, 1976.

The foregoing resolution was on November 19, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by ArticleIX, Section 3 of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
